Creative Grief Holiday Activity

Instructions:

- 1. Mix cinnamon and glitter with air clay.
- 2. Roll the air clay into a thin layer and use cookie cutter to make shapes.
- 3. Skewer hole at the top of the shape so you can wire or string it for hanging.
- 4. Let it dry out overnight on butcher paper to dry.
- 5. String or wire it the next day to use an ornament, gift tag, or tree garland.

Optional:

- Add layers of decoration with stamps, pearl-ex, gelly roll pens.
- Write the name of a loved one who has died on one of the ornaments.
- Add the ornament to the tree and invite others to share memories.
