Creative Grief Holiday Activity

Instructions:

- 1. Tape your stencils onto the jars so you have your hands free to paint.
- 2. Paint in the stencil shape with the black acrylic paint. Let dry ½ hour.
- 3. Remove your stencil. You may want to use fine point brush at that point to paint crisper edges to your shape. If so, let dry another ½ hour.
- 4. Use white ink pen to write in names of loved ones you are remembering.
- 5. Fill jar with water. Place floating candle inside. Light candles for your holiday table center piece as a way of including *all* family members.

Optional:

- Put the names on by using alphabet stickers instead of gelly pen.
- Wrap holiday ribbon around the top of the jar threads.

- Clear jars
- Black acrylic paint
- Applicator and/or brush
- White ink gel pen
- Stencils of holiday shapes
- Tape
- Floating candles
- Water

- Fine point brush
